### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicant must be a senior who will be graduating from a public high school or a first-year freshman who will be a student in the fall of 2020, and must have the following:

- ★ Acceptance into a university/four-year college (special consideration will be given to students attending a Historically Black College or University, HBCU). In addition, consideration will be given to applicants pursuing a vocational education program.
- ★ A minimum weighted 3.00 GPA – Vocational applicants must have a 2.60 GPA or higher.
- ★ Citizenship in the United States or a Resident Alien (Green Card holder).
- ★ Residency in either Escambia County or Santa Rosa County.

**Note:** Students obtaining a standard high school diploma through Florida Virtual School will be considered.

### **Application Requirements**

***All application materials must be submitted together (i.e., application, essay, recommendation letter(s), test scores, an official high school transcript, and any additional documentation). The application must be mailed to Delta Iota Omega Chapter, P. O. Box 2403, Pensacola, FL 32513-2403 and must be postmarked on or before February 14, 2020. Incomplete applications will not be considered.***

**High school transcript and SAT or ACT Score(s)** – Any combination of the highest available scores will be used in determining applicant's score(s). Scores within a two-year period of the test dates are considered valid for eligibility purposes.

**Essay** – “Explain why do you want to go to college and how do you envision the next four/five years will shape your future?” **This essay will be the applicant's formal writing sample and a critical factor in determining eligibility and acceptance as a scholarship candidate. Applicant's essay must be a minimum of three typed, double-spaced pages in length. In addition, please proofread your essay as content, formatting, spelling, and grammar will be evaluated. Effective essays are well organized and written in a formal writing voice.**

**Letter of Recommendation** – Must come from a high school assistant principal, dean, teacher, or guidance counselor. If you are a Florida Virtual School student, you may submit a letter of recommendation from a community leader.
